Summary to the attention of the Reformation Jubilee Committee of the Hungarian Government

7th Hungarian Reformed World Summit

According to the decision of the Hungarian Reformed General Convent in the Carpathian Basin, the 7th Hungarian Reformed World Summit will take place in 2014 to celebrate two anniversaries in the Reformed Church. 2014 marks the closure of the Calvin Jubilee Years, which began in 2009 on the occasion of the 500th anniversary of the reformer's birth, and also serves as a year of thanksgiving for the Hungarian Reformed Church's past five years of service. The Hungarian Reformed community was constituted on 22th May 2009 with the signing of the Common Constitution of the reformed churches in the Carpathian Basin.

The motto of the 7th Hungarian Reformed World Summit: "**May your deeds be shown to your servants**" (Psalm 90:16)

Publication of the second revision of the new translation of the Bible

The revision of the translation is completed and the publication and printing of the new Bibles is on course.

The expected date of publication is Easter Day (20th April 2014). We will give thanks for the completed work within the framework of an ecumenical worship starting at 6 p.m. on 27th April 2014 in the Lutheran church located at the Castle in Budapest.
